Amos 7:12-15; 2 Ephesians 1:3-14; Mark 6:7-13

Dear Sisters and brothers in Christ,

This weekend we are presented with one of my favourite gospel passages; Jesus sending the twelve apostles and giving them instructions on how to go about the mission. The disciples stuck to the terms of the mission and their ministry was successful and fruitful. I really love this passage because it has always guided my ministry over the years. Jesus said to them; "take nothing for the journey...." By saying this, he was reassuring them that the Lord sending them out will always look after them; that the Master of the mission will always provide for them. There was no need for them to worry.

It is very hard to think that I have only been with you for six months. It really feels way longer than that (in a very good way). It feels as if I have been part of the furniture (family) for a long time, all thanks to you all; the awesome parishioners of Kingaroy and Nanango. When I was appointed, I wasn't sure what to expect. As I said a couple of weeks ago, you all are family and I can't thank God enough for what he's doing through you all. Whenever I head out of the parish for something, I always look forward to returning 'home'. I just want you all to know that I am and will ever remain grateful to you all for your love, acceptance and support. I love you all. Let us continue to journey together. Together we can continue achieve awesome things for God!

As I go overseas to visit my 'biological' family and friends (for 3 weeks), I will miss you all and won't be long. I'll carry all your regards to them. I thank Frs. Dan Grundy and Subin Thomas who will be generously holding the fort for us during this time.
